## **SENATE BILL No. 820**

February 13, 2018, Introduced by Senator ZORN and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"
by amending section 3101a (MCL 500.3101a), as amended by 2014 PA
419.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3101a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
an insurer, in conjunction with the issuance of an automobile
insurance policy, as defined in section 3303, shall provide 2
certificates of insurance for each insured vehicle. The insurer
shall mark 1 of the certificates as the secretary of state's copy,
which copy, except as otherwise provided in this section, shall be
filed with the secretary of state by the policyholder upon
application for a vehicle registration. The secretary of state
shall not maintain the certificate of insurance received under this
subsection on file.

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- 1 (1) (2) Beginning December 30, 2011, an AN insurer, in
- 2 conjunction with the issuance of an automobile insurance policy,
- 3 shall provide to the insured 1 certificate of insurance for each
- 4 insured vehicle, and, SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (6), for private
- 5 passenger nonfleet automobiles listed on the policy shall supply to
- 6 the secretary of state , in the format and timeline as required by
- 7 the secretary of state, which shall not be required more frequently
- 8 than every 14 days, the automobile insurer's name, the NAME OF THE
- 9 named insured, the named insured's address, the vehicle
- 10 identification number for each such vehicle listed on the policy,
- 11 and the policy number. THE INSURER SHALL TRANSMIT THE INFORMATION
- 12 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IN A FORMAT AS REQUIRED BY THE
- 13 SECRETARY OF STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT REQUIRE THE
- 14 INFORMATION TO BE TRANSMITTED MORE FREQUENTLY THAN EVERY 14 DAYS.
- 15 (2) Until December 31, 2018, OR UNTIL THE INFORMATION IS NO
- 16 LONGER SUPPLIED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION
- 17 (6), WHICHEVER IS EARLIER, the secretary of state shall provide
- 18 policy information received under this subsection (1) to the
- 19 department of community health AND HUMAN SERVICES as required for
- 20 the department of community health AND HUMAN SERVICES to comply
- 21 with 2006 PA 593, MCL 550.281 to 550.289. In determining the format
- 22 under this subsection, the secretary of state shall consult with
- 23 insurers. As used in this subsection, "private passenger nonfleet
- 24 automobile" means that term as defined in section 3303.
- 25 (3) The secretary of state shall accept as proof of vehicle
- 26 insurance a transmission of the insured vehicle's vehicle
- 27 identification number. Policy information submitted by an insurer

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- 1 and received by the secretary of state under this section is
- 2 confidential, is not subject to the freedom of information act,
- 3 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246, and shall not be disclosed to
- 4 any person except the department of community health AND HUMAN
- 5 SERVICES for purposes of 2006 PA 593, MCL 550.281 to 550.289, or
- 6 pursuant to an order by a court of competent jurisdiction in
- 7 connection with a claim or fraud investigation or prosecution. The
- 8 transmission to the secretary of state of a vehicle identification
- 9 number is proof of insurance to the secretary of state for motor
- 10 vehicle registration purposes only and is not evidence that a
- 11 policy of insurance actually exists between an insurer and an
- 12 individual.
- 13 (4) A person who FAILS TO SUPPLY INFORMATION TO THE SECRETARY
- 14 OF STATE OR WHO supplies false information to the secretary of
- 15 state under this section or who issues or uses an altered,
- 16 fraudulent, or counterfeit certificate of insurance is guilty of a
- 17 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- 18 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 19 (5) The department of community health AND HUMAN SERVICES
- 20 shall report to the senate and house of representatives
- 21 appropriations committees and standing committees concerning
- 22 insurance issues on the number of claims and total dollar amount
- 23 recovered from automobile insurers pursuant to UNDER 2006 PA 593,
- 24 MCL 550.281 to 550.289. The reports required by this subsection
- 25 shall MUST be given to the appropriations committees and standing
- 26 committees concerning insurance issues by December 30 of each year
- 27 through December 30, 2018 and shall MUST cover the preceding 12-

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- 1 month period.
- 2 (6) THE REQUIREMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (1) THAT AN INSURER
- 3 SUPPLY INFORMATION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE DOES NOT APPLY AFTER
- 4 THE DIRECTOR CERTIFIES, BY A CERTIFICATION POSTED ON THE DEPARTMENT
- 5 WEBSITE, THAT THE ELECTRONIC INSURANCE VERIFICATION SYSTEM
- 6 ESTABLISHED UNDER THE REAL-TIME ELECTRONIC INSURANCE VERIFICATION
- 7 ACT IS OPERATIONAL.
- 8 (7) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 9 (A) "AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 10 SECTION 3303.
- 11 (B) "PRIVATE PASSENGER NONFLEET AUTOMOBILE" MEANS THAT TERM AS
- 12 DEFINED IN SECTION 3303.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 14 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 15 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless Senate Bill No.819
- of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.

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
